Earth Day Bath Mat by Linda Lum DeBono

This is a general pattern. Cut the size of the bath mat to the size that you desire. Also, enlarge the letters to the size that is required for your finished mat size. Note that this IS NOT A SLIP PROOF MAT.

Materials for one towel

1 large bath towel [You can make two bath mats out of one large towel.]

1/3 yard fabric

fusible web

Cutting directions:

From the fabric,
cut three strips, 2 1/2" x 40" long [or desired length for your towel]

Directions:

Follow the manufacturer's directions and fuse the letters to the top of your fabric. Do be worried if the letters don't stick down completely. This is enough for the letters to stay in place while you stitch around the letters.

Use matching thread and sew a zigzag stitch all around the letters.

Trim the towel to the desired dimensions and bind.



Note: The letters given here are different from the one in the actual photograph.
